

All the Light We Cannot See by Anthony Doerr

Note: All the Light We Cannot See, a 2014 National Book Award Finalist, will soon be available to be checked

out in the EBC Library. In Paris, 1934, lives a young girl, who is blind, and her remarkable

father, a curator at the Paris

Museum of Natural History. At the same time a brilliant orphaned boy lives in a small German mining town. Their lives could not be more different, yet they are connected, through the miracle of sound. Through the next ten years of the Nazi regime of terror - the turmoil and loss of French occupation - the inhumane training of the best and brightest in a Hitler Youth Camp their lives are forever changed. Then in 1944, sound again brings a brief convergence of their lives that restores our belief that there is good in the world and it can survive in the face of horror. The last faint connection of their lives in 2014 is poignant and life affirming. The book gives detailed insight into the lives of ordinary people during the Nazi occupation of France and the brutal and ruthless
