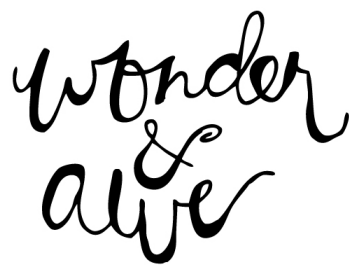

Dr. Burleson is a Baylor grad, receiving his Bachelor of Arts in Sociology and Business from Baylor in 1980. He went on to receive his Master of Divinity from Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary in 1985 and his Doctor of Ministry from Austin Presbyterian Theological Seminary in 1992.

Before he started working as University Chaplain in 2007, Dr. Burleson was the pastor of DaySpring Baptist Church in Waco for 12 years.

Burt and his wife Julie have been married since 1982, and they have two children, Abby and Brandt.
