At the regularly scheduled business meeting on Wednesday, June 15, the Building Committee brought a recommendation to begin the renovation work for our three-story Education Building and the exteriors of other church buildings. The recommendation passed with no negative votes.

From the Pastor...

At the regularly scheduled business meeting on Wednesday, June 15, the Building Committee brought a recommendation to begin the renovation work for our three-story Education Building and the exteriors of other church buildings. The recommendation passed with no negative votes. Construction is scheduled to begin in mid-July.

- The bowling alley area is cleared and ready for use as temporary storage during the renovation project. **Bowling alley remnants are available FREE on a first come, first serve basis** [bowling balls (69); racks (3); pins (12); and shoes in various sizes 2 through 12].
