## CLECO STOCK

**Is it too late to make a charitable contribution using my Cleco shares?**  
Time is running out. It takes three to five business days for Computershare to process a charitable contribution request. In addition, transferring ownership of stock requires certain steps on the shareholder's part that could add a day or two to the process. They will continue to process through the date of closing.

### If I am interested in donating my shares to a charitable institution, when should I do this? Before or after the transaction closes?

To receive full tax benefits, you should donate your shares prior to the close of the transaction and avoid any capital gains tax. You can deduct the full value of the asset on your taxes, and the charity gets the full benefit as a non-profit agency.
