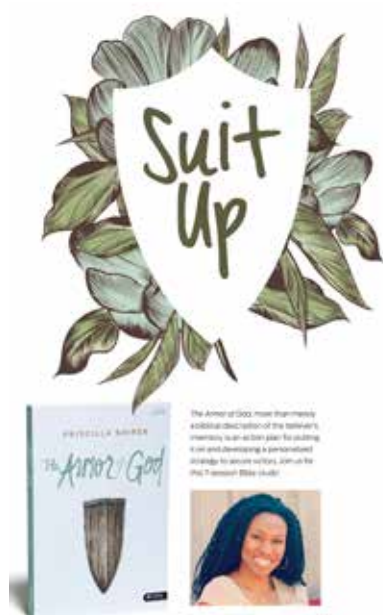

RSVP to ride the float by Friday, February 22. 1st - 6th grade riders and chaperones must RSVP to the church office to ride in the March 2 parade on the Krewe of Emmanuel float. Due to limited float space, children who participate in Wednesday/Sunday activities will have first priority. ALL children must have a medical release form on file to ride the float. We'll decorate the float on Wednesday, February 27. Bring your own throws (beads and/or candy) and wear your Krewe of Emmanuel t-shirt. Adults needed to chaperone as float riders or walkers.
