RSVP to the church office by Thursday, February 28. Church members of all ages are invited to a Children's Mardi Gras Parade Watching Party. We'll meet in front of the Sanctuary on Saturday, March 2, to watch the parade, which begins at 10 a.m., then stick around for pizza and king cake in Weems Hall. Parade watching is free, but lunch is \$3 for children 11 & under, \$5 for ages 12 to adult or \$15 family max.
