Barbee Meal Train

Rhoda Barbee is handling her chemo treatments well to this point. Her bandage and wound vac changes are becoming more bearable as her leg heals from the drastic surgery.

We originally set up the Meal Train to provide for Rhoda and her family through six chemo treatments. The new plan is for her to receive a total of twelve chemo treatments so more dates have been added to the Meal Train calendar. These meals, provided by Emmanuel members, have become even more important to Rhoda and her family since her mother fell and hurt her back. The injury, along with the travel to get Rhoda's treatments, has made it more difficult to handle all of the home responsibilities. This is a real way we can minister to the Barbee family during this very difficult time. Thank you for participating in this ministry.
