New Supper Prices begin August 8

- Adult Supper - \$6
- Child Supper - \$3.50
- Family Max - \$18

Full Wednesday night suppers with the child menu option resume August 8. At that time the meal prices will increase to the amounts proposed by the 2015 Budget Planning Committee and approved along with the 2016 church budget. Breakfast resumes on Sunday, August 5 with no change in prices.

The Food Service budget, which covers food purchases, kitchen supplies, paper products and the wages of kitchen workers, was reduced from \$6,000 in 2015 to \$2,000 in 2018.
